Introvert (noun)	A person who gains energy from quiet time and internal reflection.	<i>As an introvert, Sarah prefers reading a book to attending a loud concert.</i>
Extrovert (noun)	A person who is energized by social interaction and the external world.	<i>The extrovert in the group was the first one to start dancing.</i>
Outgoing (adjective)	Friendly and energetic when meeting or talking to other people.	<i>He is very outgoing and makes new friends wherever he goes.</i>
Solitude (noun)	The state of being alone, especially when this is peaceful or pleasant.	<i>She sought the solitude of the mountains to clear her mind.</i>
Recharging (verb/gerund)	Regaining energy or strength by resting or doing something quiet.	<i>After a long week of meetings, I need some time for recharging.</i>
Socialize (verb)	To spend time when you are not working with friends or with other people.	<i>It is important for teenagers to socialize with their peers.</i>
Stimulating (adjective)	Encouraging new ideas or making you feel enthusiastic and full of energy.	<i>The classroom discussion was very stimulating and thought-provoking.</i>
Reflective (adjective)	Thinking carefully and quietly about something.	<i>His reflective nature makes him a very good poet.</i>
