Genre (noun)	A style or category of art, music, or literature.	<i>Science fiction is my favorite film genre.</i>
Plot (noun)	The main events of a play, novel, or movie.	<i>The plot of the movie was very difficult to follow.</i>
Cast (noun)	The actors taking part in a movie or play.	<i>The movie has a star-studded cast including Tom Hanks.</i>
Predictable (adjective)	Behaving or happening in a way that is expected.	<i>The ending was predictable, so I wasn't surprised.</i>
Gripping (adjective)	Firmly holding the attention or interest; exciting.	<i>It was such a gripping story that I couldn't look away.</i>
Soundtrack (noun)	The music used in a film.	<i>The soundtrack features many famous pop songs.</i>
Hilarious (adjective)	Extremely funny.	<i>That new comedy special on Netflix is absolutely hilarious.</i>
Recommendation (noun)	A suggestion that something is good or suitable.	<i>Do you have a recommendation for a good horror movie?</i>
