Word	Definition	Example
Genre (noun)	A specific category or type of entertainment, such as comedy or horror.	<i>My favorite movie genre is romantic comedy because they always have happy endings.</i>
Thriller (noun)	A book or film with an exciting story, often about crime or mystery.	<i>The new spy thriller was so intense that I couldn't look away from the screen.</i>
Sci-fi (noun)	Fiction based on imagined future scientific or technological advances.	<i>In that sci-fi movie, humans lived in a giant city on the planet Mars.</i>
Plot (noun)	The main sequence of events that make up the story of a movie.	<i>The plot was very confusing, so I didn't understand why the hero left.</i>
Cast (noun)	All the actors who act in a particular movie or play.	<i>The movie has a famous cast, including several Oscar-winning actors.</i>
Soundtrack (noun)	The music that accompanies a movie.	<i>I bought the soundtrack because the songs in the film were beautiful.</i>
Entertaining (adjective)	Providing amusement or enjoyment to the audience.	<i>Even though it was a long movie, it was very entertaining and fun.</i>
Predictable (adjective)	Behaving or occurring in a way that is expected and not surprising.	<i>The horror movie was predictable; I knew exactly when the monster would appear.</i>

Making Comparisons

To compare two movies or genres, use comparative adjectives. For short adjectives, add '-er' (e.g., faster). For long adjectives, use 'more' (e.g., more exciting).

- *Horror movies are scarier than comedies.*
- *Sci-fi films are often more expensive to make than dramas.*
- *The soundtrack is better than the plot.*

Expressing Preferences

Use 'prefer' to talk about things you like more than others. The structure is 'prefer [A] to [B]'.

- *I prefer watching movies at home to going to the cinema.*
- *She prefers thrillers to romances.*

READING PASSAGE

When choosing a movie to watch on a Friday night, the first thing most people look at is the **genre**. Some viewers love the high-speed action and suspense of a **thriller**, while others prefer the futuristic worlds and advanced technology found in **sci-fi**. A strong **plot** is essential for keeping the audience engaged from start to finish, as a weak story can make even the most expensive film feel dull. However, a movie is more than just its story; the **cast** of actors must bring the characters to life with convincing performances. Many people also enjoy a powerful **soundtrack** that matches the mood of the scenes, whether it is a haunting melody or an upbeat pop song. While some big-budget movies are very **entertaining** and keep you on the edge of your seat, others can be quite **predictable**, making it easy to guess the ending before the halfway point. Personally, I prefer animated films because they are often more creative than live-action ones. When we discuss movies with friends, we often compare them to find the best ones to watch together.
