Word	Definition	Example
Destination (noun)	The place to which someone is going or being sent.	<i>Paris is a very popular tourist destination.</i>
Itinerary (noun)	A planned route or journey; a list of places to visit.	<i>Our itinerary includes three days in Rome and two in Venice.</i>
Budget (noun)	An estimate of income and expenditure for a set period of time.	<i>We need to stick to our budget so we don't run out of money.</i>
Accommodation (noun)	A room, group of rooms, or building in which someone may live or stay.	<i>The hotel provided excellent accommodation for the guests.</i>
Sightseeing (noun)	The activity of visiting places of interest in a particular location.	<i>We did a lot of sightseeing during our trip to London.</i>
Transport (noun)	A system or means of conveying people or goods from place to place.	<i>Public transport in the city is very efficient.</i>
Reservation (noun)	An arrangement to have something kept for one's use, such as a seat or a room.	<i>I made a reservation at the restaurant for 8:00 PM.</i>
Spontaneous (adjective)	Performed or occurring as a result of a sudden inner impulse.	<i>The couple took a spontaneous trip to the coast.</i>
